


# COPAN RUINS TOURIST ATTRACTIONS



Discovered in 1570, the ruins of Copan; one of the most important sites of the Mayan civilization, were only excavated in the 19th century and declared World Heritage by UNESCO in 1980.

El Puente Archaeological Park: 15 minutes from La Entrada and 60 kilometers from the Copán Ruinas Archaeological Park; El Puente is a 22 square kilometer park. Built around 570 AD. C. as a satellite city of Copán to control the trade routes to central Honduras. After the collapse of Copán, it is considered the second most important city of the Mayan culture.




# Sculpture Museum

Located northeast of the Archaeological Site, Las Sepulturas, which is actually a residential group members of the elite of Copán lived, the Casa del Escribano or Casa de los Bacabs stands out, and other residences that have fine architecture, facades with mosaic reliefs, and benches with reliefs and inscriptions.
